



# DID YOU KNOW???

The annual operating budget for TISD is \$8.6 Million

Markham Elementary and Blessing Elementary were both built in the 1930's

At \$0.9747, TISD has the lowest tax rates compared to other area districts.

Only 10% of TISD taxes are collected from single family homes. 21% of the taxes collected are from industrial property and 35% from industrial personal property.

The average monthly cost of electricity for TISD is \$25,832.

School District taxes on resident homesteads are frozen in the year a taxpayer turns 65 years of age and will not increase as a result of a school bond election.

TISD has no bond debt.

A Programs and Facilities Advisory Committee studied the present and future needs of the District in the areas of facilities, technology, and instructional needs, meeting over 20 times in the last 23 months.

TISD serves an average of 656 lunches daily.
