

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Procedures

Periodically bad weather will cause the closing of schools. When such weather conditions exist, administrators (as mentioned) will do the following:

SCHOOLS

- A. In the event that there is a question regarding schools being dismissed early, delayed in opening, or being closed due to bad weather, the principal will do the following:
 - 1. Inform the staff to listen for early morning news bulletins about the closing of schools through the following television and radio media:
