Dear Parents,

MEHOP will come to Tidehaven ISD to provide this one time offer of giving your school age child a flu vaccine. The vaccine will be the state recommended ***SEASONAL FLU VACCINE***.

The date MEHOP will be on campus to vaccinate students: ***December 7, 2011***.

If you would like to have your school age child/children vaccinated, MEHOP requires the attached forms to be completed and turned in to the school office by ***December 2, 2011***. Students will not be denied the vaccine due to financial reason.

MEHOP will not require a parent to be present during the vaccination provided all forms are completed and turned in on time. A part of the information requirement is a reliable phone number to be able to contact a parent.
