

The School Health Advisory Committee met on December 1, 2010 at 3:45p.m in the TISD Boardroom. The minutes were approved from November 8<sup>th</sup> meeting. Ms. Boyett reported on the texting/drinking and driving presentation that all of the High School students participated in on October 28<sup>th</sup>. She stated that the program was well received and beneficial to the student body. Students had the opportunity to experience the effects of drinking and driving and/or texting and driving and its consequences. Additionally, on November 8<sup>th</sup>, the High School and Jr. High students viewed the presentation "Behind the Faces" by Motivational Productions. This production will address making choices, friendship and bullying. Mr. Talley and Ms. Boyett again reported this presentation was received positively by the student body.

Ms. Hoffman reviewed the agreement the District entered into with the Matagorda County Rural Health Coalition. Ms. Hoffman stated that she is investigating the possibility of providing flu shots for the student body.

Ms. Boyett reported that District Attorney Steven Reis is going to do a presentation for the High School students on sexting. Mr. Talley is going to see if a similar type program can be done for the Jr. High students.
