

SHAC minutes: October 20, 2011

The Student Health Advisory Committee met on Thursday, October 20th at 3:45 in the Tidehaven ISD Administration Building. The first order of business was to elect a president and vice-president. Ms. Willie Sardenia was elected President and Leticia Aparicio was elected Vice-President. District Nurse, Kathy Hoffman reviewed procedures for staff flu shots, which will be given on October 26th. In November, MEHOP will provide free flu shots for students. Ms. Hoffman discussed having the Health Department providing the required vaccinations for the students enrolling in Pre-K, the 6th graders and 12th graders. This service will have to be located at a community location. Ms. Hoffman also made arrangements with the campuses to provide dental services to students.
